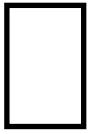

| <b>After Hours</b>   | After hours number for <b>emergencies only</b> is 0403 110 833  |
| <b>Pets</b>          | Pets are permitted in the park but must be on a lead and cleaned up after completely.   |
| <b>Power</b>         | All powered sites require a 15amp rated lead. A few sites need longer leads (20m).  |
| <b>Water</b>         | There are two sets of taps around the park. All of the white taps are for drinking water.   |
| <b>Sites</b>         | Each powered site has a drinking water supply and a sullage point. Please empty all waste water into this point, not to be used for Chemical Toilet emptying (see below)<br>Please leave your site clear of litter on departure.                    |
| <b>Smoking</b>       | Please note that smoking is not permitted in or within five (5) metres from any building.   |
| <b>Vehicles</b>      | One car per site is allowed and must be parked on the right of the site, not across the front of the site.  |
| <b>RV Dump Point</b> | The Caravan Park has a fully operational RV Dump point for chemical toilet disposal.  |
| <b>Security</b>      | Please do not leave any personal items of value outside your accommodation overnight, or during the day if away from the site. Unfortunately, petty theft does occur.   |
| <b>Camp Fires</b>    | Camp fire pits are available for use; however, lighting of fires is strictly prohibited during Restricted and Prohibited burning periods  |

## Park Rules

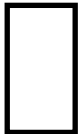
To make everyone's stay in the park as enjoyable as possible please follow these few simple rules.

| <b>Visitors</b>         | All are welcome during your stay, and must park in the over flow area. You are responsible for your guest's behaviour.<br>Visitors intending to stay overnight must be registered at reception, fees payable.   |
| <b>Noise</b>            | There is a noise curfew of 10pm, please consider others.  |
| <b>Speed Limit</b>      | Walking pace for all cars and bicycles.   |
| <b>Bicycles</b>         | Bicycles are welcome at the Park. The town has some very good walking and riding trails.  |
| <b>Responsibilities</b> | Parents are responsible for controlling and supervising the behaviour of their children, for their own safety and the comfort of others.<br>Park patrons use these facilities at their own risk; no responsibility will be taken by the park management for any loss or damage to persons, property or equipment. |
| <b>Ablutions</b>        | Children are to be accompanied by a parent in the ablutions at all times.   |
| <b>Glass</b>            | Do not take any glass items into the facilities.  |
| <b>Rubbish</b>          | Please wrap all rubbish before placing in bins.   |
| <b>Payment</b>          | Full payment is due prior to check in.  |

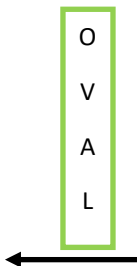
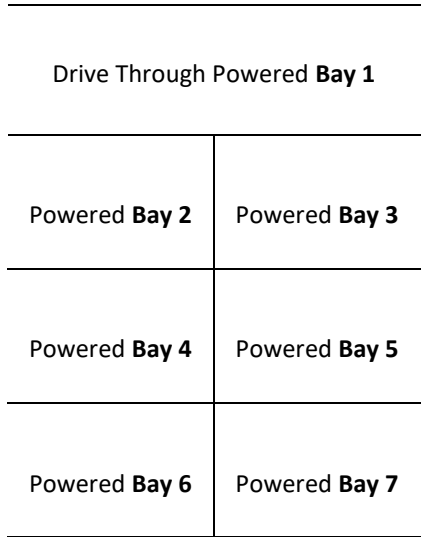

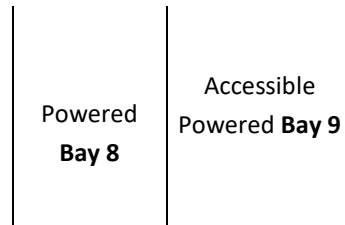
Chalet 1



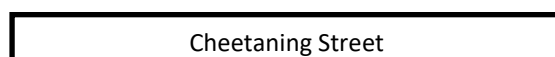
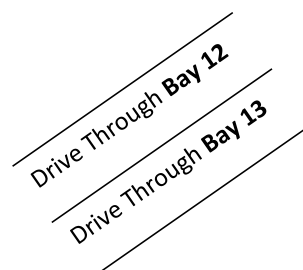
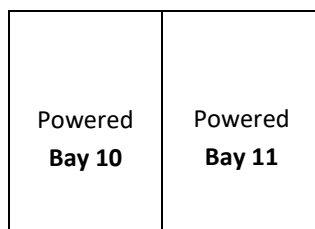
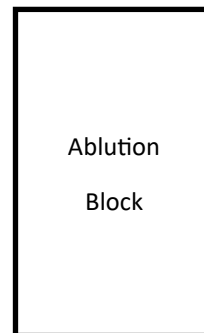

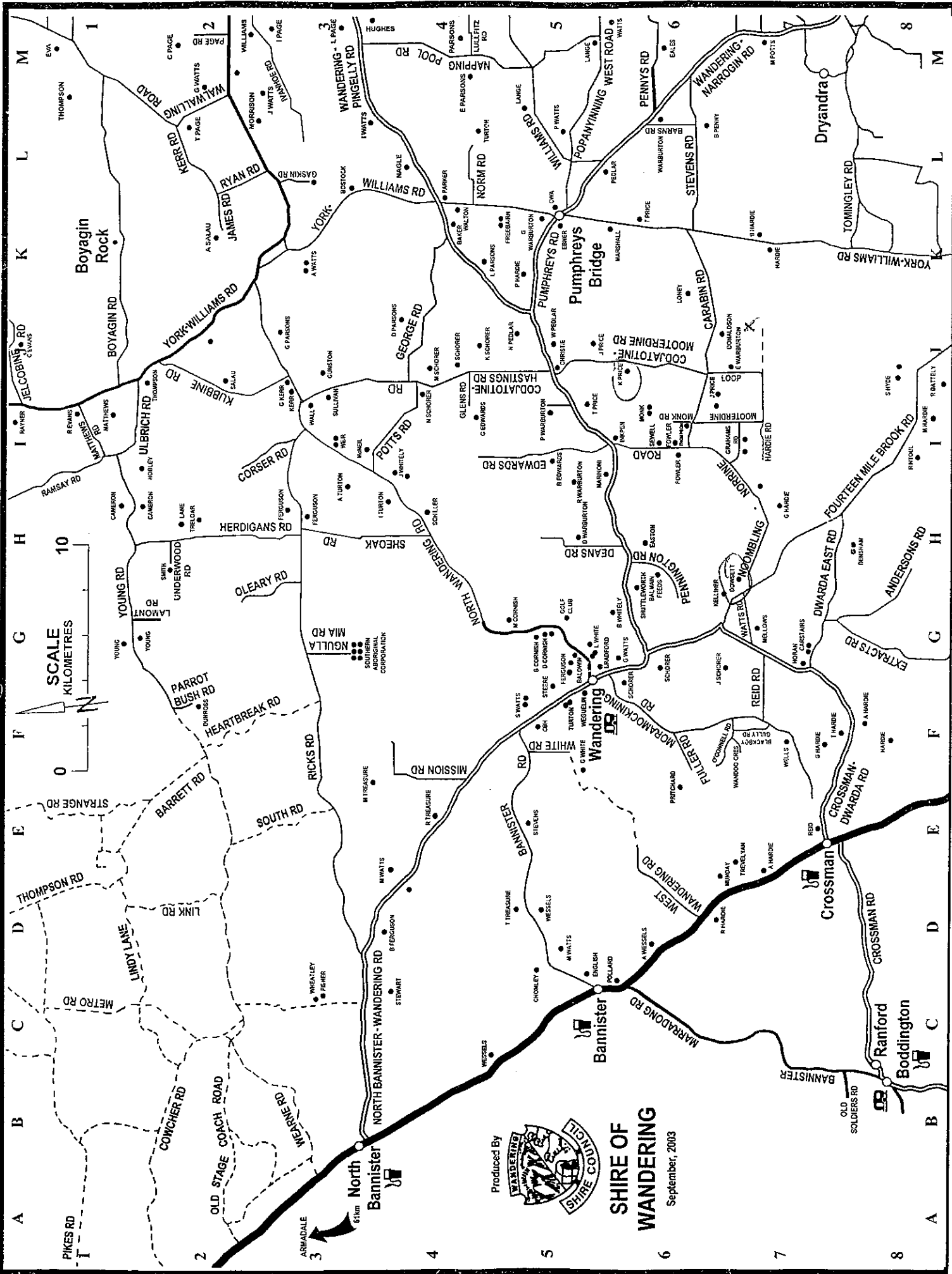


Fire Pit
