REPORT to UPGRADE COMMITTEE 12 May 2025

Since the last Project Manager report, the following items have taken place and are presented to the Community Centre Upgrade Committee Meeting on 14 May for consideration and acceptance:

Community Centre Kitchen Upgrade:

The internal painting is complete and the vinyl flooring has been laid to the kitchen and store room areas.

The stainless steel benches have been installed to kitchen and bar areas. As of yesterday (Sunday) the two ovens are still to be installed, and the plumbing and electrical final fit-out still to be done.

The contract completion was originally required at 30 April 2025. A re-check of the contract documentation shows that due to the commencement being delayed for reasons of the 150th celebtation event and the Kevin Schorer funeral, Stallion Homes advised of an extended completion date of 14 May 2025.
