4. General Business

4.1 Management of Donation funds

At the last meeting the Committee directed the CEO to appropriately accept and manage funds and inkind contributions pledged for this purpose and report back to this sub-committee. Accordingly, the following donations have been received to date.

The Wandering Camp Out Committee have pledged \$10,000 towards this project. The Lions Club will match donations up to \$10,000. Hence, currently a total of approximately \$24,920 has been pledged towards this project.

The committee agreed that the funds should be used for the BBQ shade area in the first instance and the management of any leftover funds would be determined at a later date.

It was suggested that community members with trade skills be utilised to assist with the build to reduce costs. The issue of building certification was identified as a matter that would require consideration for compliance and insurance purposes. Information is to be obtained in relation to comparative costs of this approach.

Action: The CEO is to readvertise the public appeal for donations, both monetary and in-kind, towards this project with an end date for donations to be Friday 19th December 2025.

Action: Operations Manager to source quotes and designs for the BBQ shade sail for consideration by the committee at the next meeting.

Action: D Ebsary to identify and list all essential kitchen items needed to ensure the new kitchen is fully functional e.g. platters.

4.2 Committee members

B Whitely tabled for consideration by the committee the addition of another community member to the group. Currently there are 3 councillors and 3 community members on the committee. It was proposed that another community member is added to this committee to ensure there are more community members than councillors represented on the membership of this committee.

Cr Max Watts, who recently retired as a councillor, has been a long-serving member of the group, originally joining as a community representative when the group was first established.

It was proposed that Max Watts be invited back to the committee as a community member representative.
