4. Closure of Meeting

REPORT to UPGRADE COMMITTEE 16 November 2023

The committee last met on Wednesday 11 October at 7.00pm, when the group discussed the progress of the Community Centre Upgrade to date.

The next Upgrade Committee meeting was originally scheduled for Wednesday 8 November however this was in postponed until 22 November due to the following:

- Although Whitney Consulting had been engaged by the Shire of Wandering to provide a business case and grant development, Whitney was not ready to provide anything to the Upgrade Committee, and
- Lynette Johnston (kitchen designer) was working on the design development but was also not ready to table anything to the Committee.

Since that date, Lynette has advised that she will be able to attend the Upgrade Committee meeting on Wednesday 22 November to further the proposed new kitchen design.

With regards to the new patio installation, the following is the present status:

- The building contractor attended site on 23 October to mark out the footing positions for the patio installation. The actual position was altered slightly from the plan positions to avoid a conflict with the ramp entry and stairway down to the oval.
- The contractor's team was on site on 25 October to excavate and concrete the six outer and seven inner footings for the patio.
- The footings will remain curing and hardening until Tuesday 28 November, when the contractor will return and begin the patio frame erection. This will include removing part of the roof cladding and structure of the Community Centre building to achieve its new profile.
- A crane and an electrician will be on site on Thursday 30 November to fix the roof panels, while at the same time the electrician will be installing the cables in the panels for the ceiling lights.
- If required, the contractor will return the following week to install any required flashings or undertake any other related work.

Prior to the contractor's arrival on 28 November, the Shire will arrange for the removal of the gazebo and shade structure, both of which presently intrude into the footprint of the new patio.

The contractor has confirmed that the patio installation will be well completed before Christmas.

At this stage, the future location of both the gazebo and shade structure have not yet been confirmed, so will be very much open for further discussion and proposals.
