Guest Information

The following information is provided to help you have the most relaxed and enjoyable stay possible.

Payment	The Shire accepts payments during business hours, Monday to Friday, 8:30am to 4:30pm. After hours payments can be made, and the Communal Kitchen and Ablution Facility keys obtained, by calling 0427 254 827.
Extending	If you wish to extend your stay please advise reception ASAP. We can only guarantee your site up to the date on your receipt as some sites have advanced bookings.
Pets	Pets are permitted in the park but must be on a lead and cleaned up after completely.
Power	All powered sites require a 15amp rated lead. A few sites need longer leads (20m).
Water	There are two sets of taps around the park. All of the white taps are for drinking water.
Sites	Each powered site has a drinking water supply and a sullage point. Please empty all waste water into this point, not to be used for Chemical Toilet emptying (see below) Please leave your site clear of litter on departure.
Smoking	Please note that smoking is not permitted in or within five (5) metres from any building.
Vehicles	One car per site is allowed and must be parked on the right of the site, not across the front of the site.
RV Dump Point	The Caravan Park has a fully operational RV Dump point for chemical toilet disposal.
Security	Please do not leave any personal items of value outside your accommodation overnight, or during the day if away from the site. Unfortunately, petty theft does occur.
Camp Fires	Camp fire pits are available for use; however, lighting of fires is strictly prohibited during Restricted and Prohibited burning periods

Park Rules

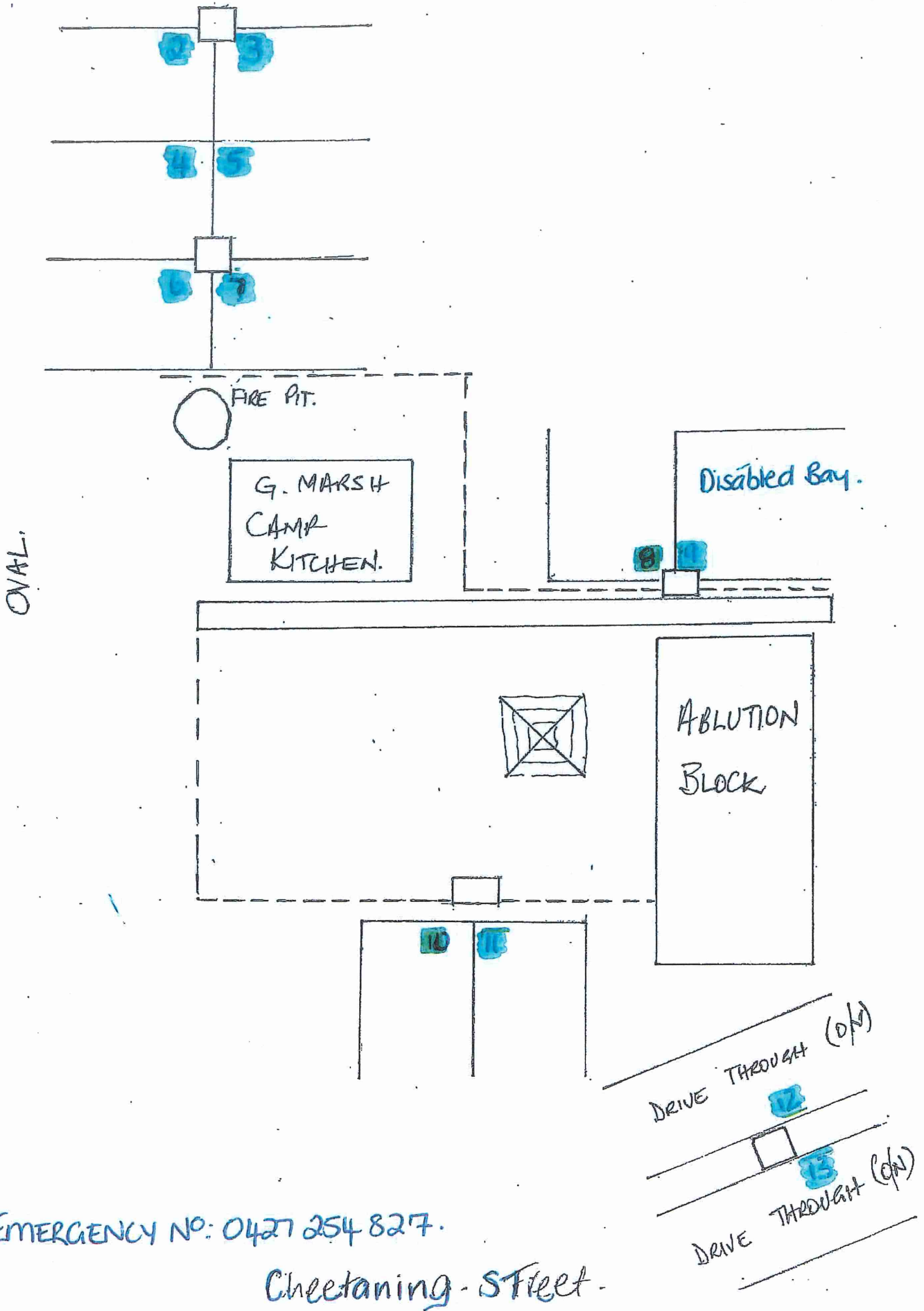
To make everyone's stay in the park as enjoyable as possible please follow these few simple rules.

Visitors	All are welcome during your stay, and must park in the over flow area. You are responsible for your guest's behaviour. Visitors intending to stay overnight must be registered at reception, fees payable.
Noise	There is a noise curfew of 10pm, please consider others.
Speed Limit	Walking pace for all cars and bicycles.
Bicycles	Bicycles are welcome at the Park. The town has some very good walking and riding trails.
Responsibilities	Parents are responsible for controlling and supervising the behaviour of their children, for their own safety and the comfort of others. Park patrons use these facilities at their own risk; no responsibility will be taken by the park management for any loss or damage to persons, property or equipment.
Ablutions	Children are to be accompanied by a parent in the ablutions at all times.
Glass	Do not take any glass items into the facilities.
Rubbish	Please wrap all rubbish before placing in bins.
Payment	Full payment is due either prior to or on check in.

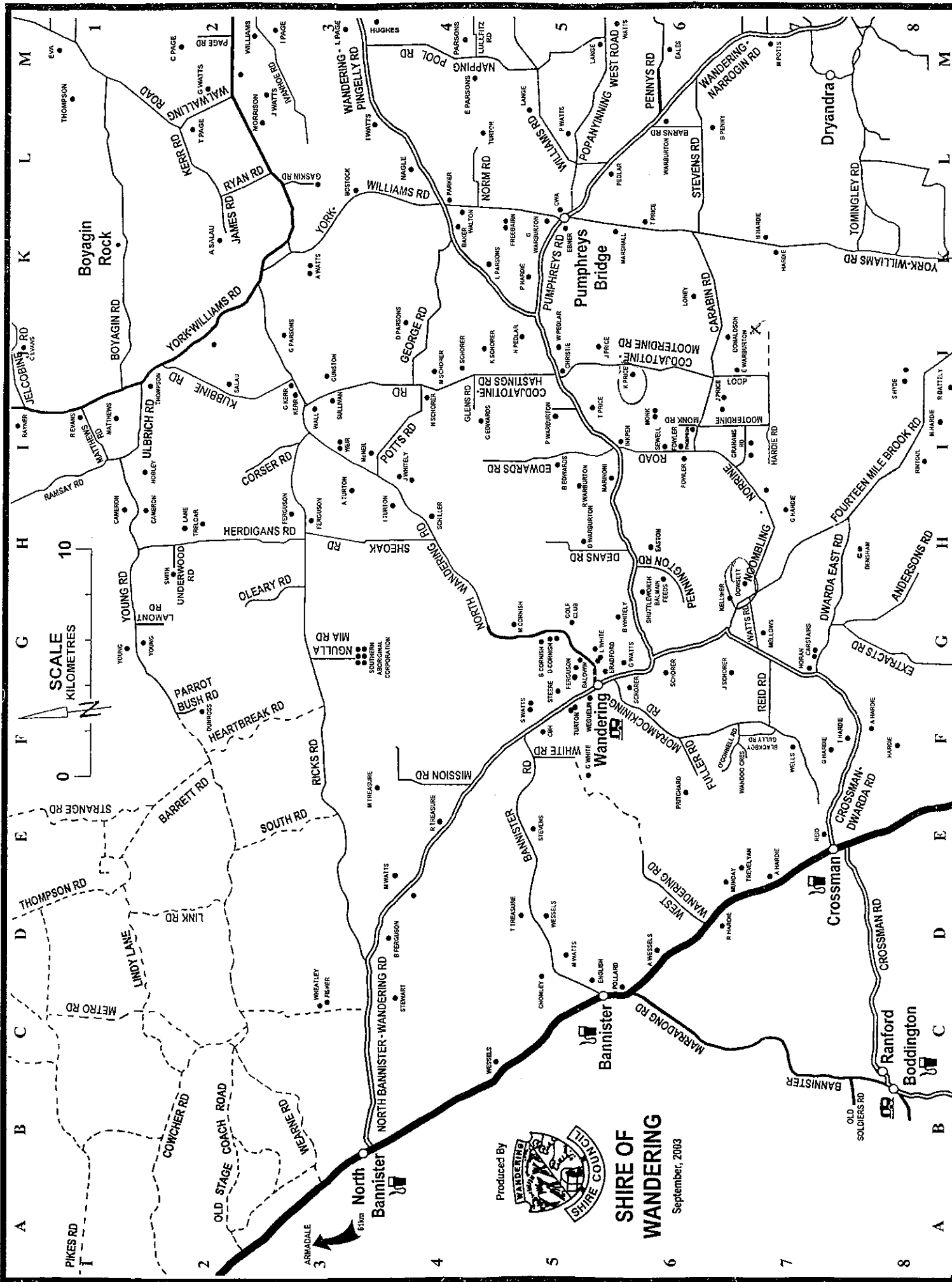
