WANDERING FUEL FACILITY

Exciting News, the 24 hour fuel facility was opened to the public on Friday 15 February 2013 and is now fully operational. There are two separate fuel dispensers, one is a dual ULP/Diesel dispenser while the second is a stand alone high flow diesel dispenser.

The facility is being well utilised and while there have been a few teething issues everything on the whole is running well. Current pricing at the time of issue is;

ULP - \$147.9 litre

Diesel - \$149.9 litre

COMMUNITY CONSULTATION NIGHT

The community consultation night held at the Community Centre on Friday 15 February 2013 was well received with approximately 80 adults in attendance.

Thanks to everyone for their feedback and the data collected from the evening has since been compiled and distributed to people that attended the evening. Data collected from the night is being used to compile a Community Strategic Plan which is scheduled to be adopted at the March 2013 Ordinary Council Meeting.

BOWLING GREEN / TENNIS COURT REFURBISHMENT

Courtesy of grant funding received in excess of \$335,000 the old tennis courts at the Community Centre will be getting a refurbishment with a multi-purpose 4 rink bowling green, 2 synthetic courts, additional lighting and fencing being the main components of the new multi-purpose arena. The project was adopted in the 2012/13 budget with a total cost of \$400,000, of which \$187,795 will be funded through the Royalties for Regions Country Local Government Fund, \$147,429 from the Department of Sport and Recreation and \$64,776 contributed by the Shire of Wandering. Tenders will now be called for the construction of the multi-purpose facility. Further information on the project can be obtained by contacting the CEO at the Shire Offices on 9884 1056.
