### WANDERING FUEL FACILITY

The 24 hour fuel facility was opened to the public in February 2013 and is now fully operational. There are two separate fuel dispensers, one is a dual ULP/Diesel dispenser while the second is a stand alone high flow diesel dispenser. The facility is being well utilised and while there have been a few teething issues everything on the whole is running well. Gilbarco are conducting regular testing to address the issues and everyone's patience and understanding during this period would be greatly appreciated.

Current pricing at the time of issue is;

ULP - \$1.479 litre

Diesel - \$1.499 litre

### COMMUNITY STRATEGIC PLAN

### FIRE SEASON

A reminder that the burning period is currently **RESTRICTED** in the Shire of Wandering, meaning that a permit from your local brigade is required at all times for burning to take place. The restricted burning period remains in place until **19 April 2013**.

### DOGS

A reminder to all dog owners that all dogs must be controlled by means of a chain, cord, leash or harness when in a public or exercise area.

There have also been a few complaints in relation to the level of barking by some dogs within the town. Under the Dog Act a written complaint from a minimum of three residents from at least two different households is required before any action can be taken by the Shire ranger.

Failure to comply with the above requirements can result in fines of up to \$1,000 per offence.
