### Bowling Green / Tennis Court Refurbishment

After much consideration Council have released for public comment two concept plans for the Bowling Green / Tennis Court Refurbishment project to be completed at the Wandering Community Centre.

The project was adopted in the 2013/14 Budget and will be funded largely by grant funding received from the Royalties for Regions Program and the Department of Sport and Recreation which accounts for 84% of the project cost. The balance of the project will be funded by the Shire of Wandering through the provision of in kind plant and salaries and a small cash contribution of approximately \$15,000.

The concept plans are currently on display in the Shire Noticeboard and the Shire Office and copies of the concept plans are available for collection for any interested persons at the Shire Offices.
