### 2011/12 BUDGET

Council adopted the 2011/12 budget at the Ordinary Council Meeting held on 18 August 2011. Major works to be undertaken this year are:

#### Road Construction

Wandering Pingelly Road

Substructure repairs will also be carried out on the Crossman Dwarda Bridge.

#### Gravel Sheeting

There will be an extensive gravel sheeting program carried out throughout the year on a number of roads in the Shire, including, but not limited to the York Williams, Fourteen Mile Brook, Codjatotine Hastings, Noombling Norrine, Carabin, Bannister, North Wandering and Reid Road.

There will be some plant replacement and other minor plant purchases made during the year as per the Plant Replacement Program.
