WANDERING FUEL FACILITY

Site works are currently taking place on Watts St (opposite the Wandering Telecentre) for the development of a fuel facility within town. The fuel facility will be a 24 hour unmanned card operated service and site plans have included provision for future services to be added to the existing site should the need for such services arise. The Shire anticipates having the fuel facility operational before the end of 2010.

WANDERING PUBLIC LIBRARY

At the March Ordinary Meeting Council resolved to relocate the existing Wandering Public Library from the Shire Offices to the Wandering Telecentre. The relocation of the library to the Telecentre will mean the formation of one larger library service in Wandering which will enhance the quality of library services currently offered in Wandering as well as create additional office space in the current Shire Offices.

TOWN OVAL

The Shire are currently looking into any funding opportunities available which could be used to upgrade the town oval at the Community Centre. The viability of such as a project is dependant on a number of factors including availability of funding, sourcing an appropriate water supply and allowing for the future upkeep of the oval. The purpose of the upgrade is to provide a focal point in the community where families can meet and utilise the facilities of the Community Centre.

ROAD CONSTRUCTION WORKS

Road works on the North Bannister-Wandering Road will commence after Easter and continue through to the end of June 2010 as part of the Shire's Regional Road Group program. The majority of the work will be conducted within the first 7 km section as you enter the North Bannister Wandering Road from the Albany Highway turnoff. It is anticipated there will be some traffic delays during this period and Council apologies for any inconvenience.

BRIDGEWORKS - FOURTEEN MILE BROOK ROAD, DWARDA

Bridge maintenance and refurbishment works have commenced at the above location. The recent rainfall has delayed works, however Main Roads still anticipate the completion of the project by May 2010. Currently the bridge is closed to all traffic and detours have been put in place on the Fourteen Mile Brook Rd at the Crossman-Dwarda Rd and Dwarda East Rd intersections, with only local traffic permitted on Fourteen Mile Brook Road.
