ROAD CLOSURE

The Shire of Wandering would like to inform all landowners, surrounding Shires and other persons of interest that the **North Bannister Wandering Rd will be closed to ALL TRAFFIC from Wednesday 28 April 2010 until 30 June 2010.**

A detour will be in place during this period for traffic to be diverted along **Bannister Rd.**

Additionally, all Heavy Vehicles must comply with the following conditions which are currently in place for Bannister Rd;

- ◆ Have written LGA approval for use of this road
- ◆ Only permitted to travel during day light hours
- ◆ Maximum permitted speed 60 Kph
- ◆ No operation on unsealed road segment when visibly wet
- ◆ Direct radio contact to be maintained with other RAVs to establish their position on or near the road
- ◆ Head lights to be switched on at all times
- ◆ School bus curfews to be enforced

Council are aware that the road closure during the above period will be inconvenient for many landowners and travellers and would like to ask for your patience during the period of road closure.

Unfortunately the road closure is necessary in order for Council to complete road programs previously brought forward under the Main Roads Regional Road Group program which must be completed by the end of the 2009/10 financial year.

ROAD CONSTRUCTION WORKS

A 1km section of road on the North Wandering Rd has recently been sealed. Please make sure to take care and slow down on this new section of road.

BRIDGEWORKS - FOURTEEN MILE BROOK ROAD, DWARDA

Bridge maintenance and refurbishment works have been completed at the above location. The bridge is currently still closed to all traffic with detours in place on the Fourteen Mile Brook Rd at the Crossman-Dwarda Rd and Dwarda East Rd intersections.

WANDERING FUEL FACILITY

Site works have now been completed for the development of a fuel facility within town. The second stage of the fuel facility site is now being progressed with the Shire anticipating to have the fuel facility operational before the end of 2010.

DOGS

Residents in town are reminded that all dogs are required to be registered and must be controlled by means of a chain, cord, leash or harness when in a public or exercise area. Failure to comply with the above requirements will result in fines of up to \$1,000 per offence.
