### ROAD CLOSURE

The road works on the **North Bannister Wandering Rd** are progressing well and remain on schedule to be completed by **30 June 2010**.

The detour along **Bannister Rd** will remain in place during this period and please note that all Heavy Vehicles must comply with the following conditions which are currently in place for Bannister Rd;

- ◆ Have written LGA approval for use of this road
- ◆ Only permitted to travel during day light hours
- ◆ Maximum permitted speed 60 Kph
- ◆ No operation on unsealed road segment when visibly wet
- ◆ Direct radio contact to be maintained with other RAVs to establish their position on or near the road
- ◆ Head lights to be switched on at all times
- ◆ School bus curfews to be enforced

Council are aware the road closure has been an inconvenience for many landowners, businesses and travellers and would like to thank you all for your understanding and patience during the first month of the road closure.

### BRIDGEWORKS – FOURTEEN MILE BROOK ROAD, DWARDA

The majority of the bridge maintenance and refurbishment works have been completed at the above location and the bridge is now open to all light traffic. The 3 tonne limit for the bridge will remain in place until the final works have been completed. To date, no completion date for the final works has been given to the Shire.

### WANDERING FUEL FACILITY

The fuel facility site is still being progressed with fuel storage tanks currently being sourced. The Shire anticipates to have the fuel facility operational before the end of 2010.

### DOGS

There have been numerous reports of dogs roaming the streets in Wandering in recent months. Residents in town are reminded that all dogs are required to be registered and must be controlled by means of a chain, cord, leash or harness when in a public or exercise area. Failure to comply with the above requirements will result in fines of up to \$1,000 per offence.
