COMMUNITY CENTRE OVAL REFURBISHMENT

Work has commenced on the oval refurbishment at the Community Centre with the Shire meeting with various consultants to discuss the water supply, oval preparation and future infrastructure needs of the oval.

As part of the site preparation the oval will be sprayed on Wednesday 4 August and as a result people will be asked not to access the oval for several days following the oval being sprayed.

WANDERING FUEL FACILITY

The fuel facility site is still progressing well and contractors are now in the process of connecting telephone and electricity to the site.

There has also been an opportunity for the Shire to potentially access some additional funding for the fuel facility site through the Country Local Government Fund, previously referred to as the Royalties for Regions program.

As a result of applying for the additional funding the Shire is still hopeful on having the fuel facility operational before the end of 2010, however the finalisation of the site will hinge on the result of funding since any works funded through the CLGF must not be spent retrospectively.

WANDERING TOWN LIBRARY

WANDERING REFUSE SITE

It is becoming of increasing concern to Council that the rules associated with the Wandering Refuse Site are continually not being adhered to. The Refuse Site has clearly marked areas for Household Rubbish, Green Waste, Building Material, Scrap Metal and many other drop off points and associated waste and materials must be dumped in these areas at all times. Your cooperation in adhering to these simple rules is imperative to the continuation of the site as continued failure to adhere to these rules will ultimately result in the closure of the Refuse Site under the Environmental Protection Act.

DOGS

There have been numerous reports of dogs roaming the streets in Wandering in recent months. Residents in town are reminded that all dogs are required to be registered and must be controlled by means of a chain, cord, leash or harness when in a public or exercise area. Failure to comply with the above requirements will result in fines of up to \$1,000 per offence.
