COMMUNITY CENTRE OVAL REFURBISHMENT

The oval refurbishment has now been completed with only the finishing touches to be take place. In order to help the new turf to establish the oval will be watered regularly during the next 2-3 weeks it would be greatly appreciated is everyone could refrain from using the oval during this time to help with the establishment of the turf.

MOBILE MUSTER

The Shire will be conducting a mobile muster where there will be the opportunity to recycle your old mobile phone, battery and charger at the Shire Offices. Items that can not be accepted are household or other batteries, home phones or any other non-mobile electronic components or devices.

FIRE SEASON

A reminder that the burning period for the Shire of Wandering will be prohibited from 1 November and this will be in place until 21 February 2011 when burning with a permit may be permitted. Peter Monk will again be the Chief Fire Control Officer, while Melvin Schorer will take up the reigns as Deputy Chief Fire Control Officers. A list with all of the fire control officer contacts can be obtained free of charge from the Shire Offices.

WANDERING FUEL FACILITY

The Shire has applied for additional funding for the fuel facility site through the Country Local Government Fund. The business cases for the Fuel Facility project, and other projects under the Dryandra Region of Councils currently being prepared by the Wheatbelt Development Commission, and in turn will be assessed by the Department of Regional Development and Lands, which is scheduled to take place in November. The Shire is still hopeful of having the fuel facility operational by early 2011, however the finalisation of the site will hinge on the result of funding since any works funded through the CLGF must not be spent retrospectively.

VINTAGE MACHINERY SHED

As many of you will have noticed by now the shed to house the vintage machinery near the toilet amenities has been erected. The shed has been delayed due to a hold up from Highline being unable to complete the frontage, but once completed at the start of November, vintage machinery will be sourced to store in the shed. The Vintage Machinery Shed is a project funded under the 2008/09 Royalties for Regions program.

WANDERING REFUSE SITE

It is becoming of increasing concern to Council that the rules associated with the Wandering Refuse Site are continually not being adhered to. The Refuse Site has clearly marked areas for Household Rubbish, Green Waste, Building Material, Scrap Metal and many other drop off points and associated waste and materials must be dumped in these areas at all times. Your cooperation in adhering to these simple rules is imperative to the continuation of the site as continued failure to adhere to these rules will ultimately result in the closure of the Refuse Site under the Environmental Protection Act and offenders will be fined if they do not adhere to these simple rules.
