### OFFICE REFURBISHMENT

Council are currently reviewing plans for an office refurbishment as per the 2010/11 Budget. The draft plans include provision for a medical facility and grant funding has been received from the Peel Development Commission to contribute towards the project. Business cases for the Fuel Facility project are still being prepared by Morrison Low consultants.
