Roadworks

The bulk of the construction work on the Main Street have been completed with the road to be sealed in the last week of March and roadside kerbing to be installed in early April.

Council understand the construction of the Main Street has been an inconvenience for residents and appreciate your cooperation over the last couple of months.

Other work to be completed in the coming week is a short section of bitumen shoulder widening on the Popanyinning West Road to the Cuballing boundary and sealing sections on the North Wandering Road and Sheoak Road that were damaged during the storm damage.

Combined with the previously completed 2.5km section on the Crossman Dwarda Road, the 3.2km section on Reid Road and 2.5km of reseals on the Wandering Pingelly Road, the completion of the above works will bring to an end what has been an extensive road program for the 2013/14 financial year.

Fire Season

A reminder that the burning period is **RESTRICTED** in the Shire of Wandering from **22 February 2014 to 19 April 2014 inclusive**. Please contact your local fire brigade to obtain a permit if you would like to burn during this period.

Waste Transfer Facility

The construction of a waste transfer facility at the existing Wandering refuse will commence in April.

Once complete, non-recyclable waste will be stored and transported to nearby municipal tips rather than buried on-site. The existing tip will then be extensively rehabilitated.

The project is 100% funded by the State Government's Country Local Government Fund.

Tennis/Multi-Use Courts Refurbishment

The above projects will be undertaken concurrently with site works to be completed in April with the view to completing both projects by the end of June 2014.

Recreation Park

The skate equipment as part of Stage 1 of the Recreation Park development in Gnowing Street has been ordered and site works will commence in April. It is anticipated that Stage 1 of the project will be completed by the end of June 2014.

ADSL2

ADSL2 broadband internet services equipment have now been installed at the Wandering Telephone Exchange.

The Shire are currently in the process of changing the office to the new ADSL2 service and will provide additional information to households on utilising the new service when this information is made available.
