Roadworks

The completion of upgrade works on the Wandering—Pingelly Road through the townsites prior to the Easter break has been most welcome and feedback from the community has been very positive to date.

The works crew will be completing flood repair work on the York—Williams Road prior to commencing the winter road maintenance program.

Waste Transfer Facility

The construction of a waste transfer facility at the existing Wandering refuse has been delayed due to the need to complete flood-damaged road repairs prior to the end of June.

Once complete, non-recyclable waste will be stored and transported to nearby municipal tips rather than buried on-site. The existing tip will then be extensively rehabilitated.

The project is 100% funded by the State Government's Country Local Government Fund.

Bowling Greens

Construction of the new Bowling Greens has commenced with Council paying the initial 30% payment to contractor Evergreen Synthetic Grass.

Site works including the retaining wall will be completed in the near future.

Tennis/Multi-Use Courts Refurbishment

The refurbishment of the tennis courts will take place upon the completion of the bowling green project.

Recreation Park

The skate equipment as part of Stage 1 of the Recreation Park development in Gnowing Street has been ordered and site works will commence shortly. It is anticipated that Stage 1 of the project will be completed by the end of June 2014.

ADSL2

ADSL2 broadband internet services equipment have now been installed at the Wandering Telephone Exchange.

Activation of the new service was delayed until 23rd April 2014 due to circumstances beyond Council's control.

All internet service providers should now be able to offer Wandering residents the new service but anyone experiencing difficulties is requested to contact the Shire office.

Town Planning Scheme Review (TPS3)

Ms Tory Young has been appointed to conduct a review of the Shire of Wandering Town Planning Scheme.

This review is needed to address certain inadequacies within the existing scheme.

The review will take around 13 weeks to complete following which the new TPS #4 will be advertised for comment for a further 13 weeks prior to consideration by Council and the WA Planning Commission.
